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### Comments to the Questions you have asked

1. **Headaches, unnecessary complexity, and burdens that taxpayers - both individuals and businesses - face because of the existing system.**

**Answer: There are millions of people that do not understand the tax questions on the tax forms that they have to fill out and they don't understand why they have to fill out the forms in the first place. All they know is that the taxes should have been taken out of their checks right in the first place. Then on top of that they are faced with the burden of threat from the government that if they don't do it then they just might go to jail. This is a headache that should never be put upon the American people. This is not Freedom; this is an unlawful mandate or an execution of extortion by our own government. This is one major reason why the American people hate or think negative toward the Federal Government.**

2. **Aspects of the tax system that are unfair.**

**Answer: The Federal tax system is an unlawful tax. Under the Constitution of the United States it states that the Federal Government can not collect Direct Taxes. The Federal Government has been breaking the law for a long long time ever since the IRS was started. 4. **Goals that the Panel should try to achieve as it evaluates the existing tax system and recommends options for reform.**
